TAX RELIEF FOR DONORS

Individual taxpayers who don't itemize may have an above the line deduction for *up to* \$300 for cash donations to charities (not stock).

Individual taxpayers who do itemize don't have the 60% limit on charitable deductions for 2020 – there is no income limit on charitable donations for individuals for 2020.

Corporate taxpayers have an increased limit – 25% of taxable income (up from 10%).

Required minimum distributions for 2020 are waived.
