A LETTER FROM WELCOME HOME'S 2022 BOARD PRESIDENT

As we look back on what the year of 2021 meant to Welcome Home, it isn't difficult at all to recognize the **pure abundance of blessings** bestowed on this great organization. However, we also recognize those blessings do not come easy and they are certainly not taken for granted. We know it is only with the total unwavering support of this community and our top-notch team, that Welcome Home continues to thrive and our mission becomes ever more solid!

The health and well-being of our nation's Veterans always has been, and always will be, the number one priority of Welcome Home. With the lingering of a few challenges brought on by the world-wide Covid-19 pandemic, our staff remained vigilant in maintaining the safest environments for those precious Veterans we care for. That meant continuing to think outside the box with how we operated during yet another year of allowing very limited on-site volunteers. It meant going over and over plans for fundraising events to be absolutely certain we took the utmost safety precautions so that we could **relentlessly pursue the mission in a way that would keep our community safe**, as well. With all of that said, we are very proud to report that Welcome Home served 342 Veterans and their family members in 2021 through our programs and wrap-around services! 91% of Veterans transitioned to or maintained independent housing within 30 days of enrollment in one of our key programs – Permanent Housing Program! 75% of underemployed or unemployed Veterans who enrolled in our VETS Work program gained employment, too! These are real numbers. **These are real people**. These are real results, and this is real proof of the life changing difference Welcome Home is making on the shoulders of our passionate team and this truly special community!

While we are tremendously excited and proud of all we are able to accomplish, and at the risk of a slightly somber tone, I'd like to take a moment to express why Welcome Home's mission is so important - to honor Veterans and restore lives. Why we are so passionate about taking care of our nation's Veterans. There is a reason why the rate of homelessness among our nation's Veterans is so high. They are called to duty to protect US. They don't even know us, but are willing to put their lives on the line to fight for us. Many of us can't comprehend the toll their sacrifices take on their lives, their families, their bodies, and their minds. Freedom isn't free. I recently ran across a poem by Michael Anderson titled "Where Broken Soldiers Go" and paraphrasing it, Anderson says our nation calls these soldiers to duty and they unite as one. Sent off to war, celebrating victories, mourning great loss. "Freedom is paid at a terrible cost." Tragically, that cost is too often the lives of our brave soldiers, but second only to loss of life is the tragic loss of physical and mental abilities. Anderson goes on to say, "With devastating effects, that leave permanent scars. Shattered lives of men, what a devastating blow! Is there a place where broken soldiers go?" Well, I am here to tell you there absolutely is a place – and that place is Welcome Home. That place is Welcome Home, because Welcome Home works! That place is Welcome Home because we refuse to leave these heroes behind. That place is Welcome Home because of you, and your unwavering support!

We're approaching the halfway mark of 2022 already, and we couldn't be more excited to be planning the celebration of our 30-year anniversary this year! 30 years since our founders bought the first shelter for our Veterans to call 'home' while getting back on their feet. That's a lot of lives restored, and we feel that our momentum is growing at a faster pace now than ever before. We've had 30 years of tremendous blessings and we're not about to let up now.

So, to those of you who supported Welcome Home in 2021 in any way - whether it is through volunteering, financial contributions, hosting fundraising events or helping raise awareness - we are immeasurably grateful to you and would be honored by your continued support.



OPEN LETTER FROM A FEMALE NAVY VETERAN

"As a female Veteran currently participating in the Welcome Home Veterans shelter, I would like to thank each of you for the remarkable sensitivity and support you have shown towards female Veterans who are enrolled in this shelter's program. I am sure you are aware of the constant, toxic harassment almost every woman who has served was forced to endure during her time in the military, some so toxic it caused PTSD issues. Thank you for creating a safer space for us, within our own hallway, thus reducing some of the stressful factors in our current situation. To my knowledge, this facility is the only one that addresses the needs of homeless female Veterans in such an amazing manner.

Now, when I enter the female Veterans hallway, I notice a more peaceful, less stressful environment, and the women seem more open and relaxed. Previous to having this safer women's space, female Veterans tended to be more hypervigilant about our sense of safe personal space. You have created a valuable place for female Veterans, free of the triggers that increase our stress. By doing this, you have empowered our ability to change our circumstances, and overcome the challenging factors that led to our current homeless status. I wanted each of you to know that the kindness and assistance you have shown towards the needs of female Veterans has not gone without notice. I believe I speak for all female Veterans in residence when I say 'thank you' for being the unique and amazing group of staff members that created a safer, more empowering, and more healing space for female homeless Veterans."

"L" is on such a positive, impressive path and we know she'll go on to do great things when she transitions out of the shelter. "L" and her journey are WHY we do what we do, every single day.

CELEBRATING A SPECIAL MOMENT WITH A VETERAN & HIS BRIDE

It is not too often Welcome Home has the honor and privilege to celebrate a couple's wedding anniversary while they're guests in our shelter. Last year was an exception, and what a wonderful moment it was celebrating "J" and "W's" 61st wedding anniversary! Complete with a cake, card signed by our team, and thoughtful words shared, this is a day we won't soon forget!

This precious couple was at Welcome Home because their house was severely damaged in a flood early 2021 and they were displaced. The house was uninhabitable, and they were exploring alternative housing, including exploring if it was at all possible to repair the damage. They were very sweet and so thankful to not be street homeless after experiencing one of the most devastating moments in their life. After a few short weeks, we were able to celebrate this special couple again, when we helped move them into their new permanent, supportive housing. Their story is one of the most impactful from the year and we wanted to share with YOU, as these moments would not be possible without your generosity and hearts for the mission.




