SUPPORTIVE SERVICES:

More than "just a shelter," homeless and at-risk Veterans, and their families, have wrap-around access to programs and services that facilitate recovery through social responsibility, personal engagement, and individualized case management based the needs and goals of each person served. Welcome Home is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit charity that provides Veteran families with shelter, food, supplies, transportation, employment assistance, permanent/rapid re-housing assistance, individualized case management, advocacy, recreational activities, connection to collaborating partners for mental, physical, and VA eligible benefits, and access to a greater quality of life – a life they deserve. All at NO COST to the Veteran.

With more than 450 homeless Veterans in Missouri, and 40,000 sleeping on the streets any given night across the nation, our programs are critical to establish long term success for the homeless and at-risk Veterans population.

OUTCOMES FOR THE YEAR

In 2022:

- o Welcome Home served 342 Veterans and family members, and our goal is to serve the same, or more, annually. (342 served in 2021, 329 served in 2020, and 365 served in 2019).
- o 66% of the homeless Veterans enrolled in our Emergency & Transitional Shelter positively moved into independent, permanent housing within 104 days of enrollment in the program.
- 96% of the Veterans enrolled in our Permanent Housing Program positively obtained or maintained independent, permanent housing within 30 days of enrollment in the program.
- o 78% of the 48 underemployed or unemployed Veterans who enrolled in VETS Work gained employment.
- o 30,717 well-balanced meals were served to Veterans and family members.
- o 10,239 bed nights of services were provided to homeless Veterans and their families.
