There's a lot to be said for an organization that withstands the challenges that can come along throughout 30 years of operations. Especially a non-profit organization. In 2022, Welcome Home achieved that milestone, with <u>thirty</u> <u>years of honoring Veterans and restoring their lives.</u> We had an incredible year celebrating. Of course, we celebrated Welcome Home, but most importantly, we celebrated <u>every single life that has been changed</u> and restored throughout those 30 years. Since 1992, Welcome Home's promise is that we simply will not accept Veteran homelessness! <u>The results we achieve</u> <u>are solid confirmation that we are keeping that promise.</u>

In 2022, Welcome Home served 342 deserving Veterans and their family members through a combination of our programs and services. Of the Veterans who enrolled in our Emergency & Transitional Shelter program, 66% moved into independent, permanent housing within 104 days. 96% of Veterans enrolled in our Permanent Housing Program were successful in maintaining or obtaining independent, permanent housing within 30 days. Also in 2022, 78% of underemployed or unemployed Veterans who enrolled in VETS Work gained employment. <u>These are real lives changed and we are honored to do our</u> <u>part.</u>

Welcome Home has a team of staff that just doesn't give up. <u>There is a</u> <u>constant desire to explore how we can restore even more lives.</u> Through careful and diligent consideration, there are a number of expansion plans that give us legitimate reason to believe we will be able to drastically increase the number of Veterans we will be able to serve. Veterans like Nick who, in part, says "I appreciate everything that the Welcome Home staff have done for me, and my Veteran brothers who have fallen down hard through these tough days. <u>I feel safe to be here, and blessed to be here, knowing that people care for</u> <u>my future.</u>" There are so many Veterans like Nick, and so many people that care for Nick's future and the futures of all homeless Veterans!

Funding for Welcome Home comes through many avenues. While 60% of that funding is through state and federal government contracts and grants, 40% comes through the generosity of so very many community partners and supporters. On behalf of the Board of Directors and the entire team of staff at Welcome Home, you have our word to always be good stewards of your support and to respect the spirit with which it is given. <u>We simply can never</u> <u>overstate our gratitude for that support</u>.

# **OUR HISTORY** & OUR FUTURE

# 1992 - 2017 | FIRST SHELTER



All it took to motivate a Columbia group of Vietnam Veterans to action was for one of their brothers-in-arms to die alone on the streets. They refused to accept Veteran homelessness, invested their own money, opened a shelter, and Welcome Home was born. The first Welcome Home shelter was purchased in

1992 and operated for one sole purpose, to give homeless Veterans an address, phone number, and warm, safe place to lay their heads at night.

# 2014 - 2017 | CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Though the first shelter served it's purpose for many years, it was unacceptable we had to turn so many Veterans away due to a lack of space or funding. Between 2014-2017, Welcome Home raised \$3.5M in order to move into our

new facility debt-free – so that all future donations went to programs and services. With the support from community partners, an active Board of Directors, and passionate volunteers, we tore down an old, abandoned motel and got to work on a building a new place for our Veterans to call 'home' during their journey out of homelessness.



# 2017 - PRESENT I NEW HOME & EXPANDED PROGRAMS



In September 2017, the first group of Veterans moved into our brand new, 25,000 sqft. Emergency & Transitional Shelter and Supportive Services Center – fully equipped with features to meet the diverse needs of Mid-Missouri Veterans experiencing homelessness, or

those at risk of becoming homeless, as well as their families. Here we have tripled professional staff and capacity, expanded our programs, and strengthened our ability to carry out the mission with unwavering commitment and operational excellence. ALL SUPPORT AND WRAP-AROUND SERVICES ARE CUSTOMIZED TO MEET THE NEEDS AND GOALS OF EACH INDIVIDUAL VETERAN, INCLUDING INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT, ADVOCACY, AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO BUILD A GREATER QUALITY OF LIFE.



#### EMERGENCY & TRANSITIONAL SHELTER

32 rooms/34 beds with full bathrooms for literally homeless Veterans, including a separate corridor for our female Veterans and families, as well as ADA rooms for those with disabilities.



# VETS WORK

Job readiness training and direct support to help unemployed or underemployed Veterans find and keep meaningful employment.



#### PERMANENT HOUSING

Supportive services and temporary financial assistance to help Veterans and their families who are homeless, or at-risk of homelessness, secure or sustain permanent, affordable, and stable housing.

# "MADE IT" A Family's Life Forever Changed

Single mom and Navy Veteran, 'SK,' her two sons, and their two precious pups, found themselves homeless after moving to Missouri and being scammed by a rent-to-own fraud scheme. She had no idea where to turn or what resources were available to her family in this new, unfamiliar state. They were desperate and devastated. But, on February 28th, 2022, 'SK' <u>connected with Welcome Home, and that is when this family's housing journey and life transformation began</u>.

'SK' worked with Welcome Home and other Columbia resources <u>to build a better life for her and her</u> <u>boys</u> in Missouri. Having very limited income, we were able to provide the family temporary shelter, financial assistance and help move them into a nice apartment with a wonderful landlord.

#### But the story doesn't end there.

Despite having PTSD and trouble sleeping after her military service, 'SK' never knew she had eligibility to receive VA disability income – a benefit she earned from military service. Within a few weeks of helping 'SK' file her VA claim, she received the letter. She was rated 70%, would receive backpay, and suddenly, <u>their lives were forever changed</u>. She purchased a family vehicle and having a dream to one day own a home of her own, 'SK' started saving money to begin that journey. On January 28th, 2023, this remarkable Navy Veteran became a homeowner and in February <u>they moved into a new home – their home</u>!

'SK' was able to pay the \$1000 down for the title, appraisal, house and termite inspection, all moving costs, all the bills from the old apartment in full, her truck note and insurance, money down on her son's school trip to Yellowstone Park, and still have money left over to breathe.

Because of all of you, you and your help - Let alone belief in me that all I wanted to make happen could happen - <u>never giving up on me or my boys</u>, and in whatever ways you helped pave the way for us, <u>we made it</u>!

We made it to the point I swore we were going to be at, let alone in the exact place I said I wanted us to be at. With all your help, my VA claim being approved first time through, and the will of never giving up (even though I heard 'NO' a million times), <u>WE MADE IT</u>!

I want all of you to know that it's the things you all have done that have helped us get where we are since getting to Columbia. I'm sure all of you wonder daily if what you all do matters. I'm sure you see others succeed and others fail. I want you all to know and see that <u>not only have you helped me and my boys</u> <u>succeed, but we flew above and beyond because of everything you all did</u>.
