At Welcome Home, every single day is a day in which many homeless Veterans' lives become further restored. Every single day. All 365 days in each year. In 2023, those 365 days provided 12,823 bed nights of shelter for homeless Veterans and their families. In those 365 days, we served 34,122 delicious well-balanced meals. In those 365 days, we served 434 Veterans and family members through the combination of Welcome Home's programs and services.

We could stop there and be very pleased with all of those numbers; be satisfied that we have that amazing impact on the lives of so many who once protected us, but that's just not how we roll. That's just not all that we can do for them, and there are so many more Veterans who are just like the 434 we served in 2023. There are so many more needs to be met. Thanks to an absolute top-notch compassionate team, Welcome Home has become a well-oiled machine. The programs we have put in place are evidence-based, proven, and effective. The partnerships we have developed are strong and committed. However, the goal of all goals for us is to place every Veteran in their own home that they can sustain for themselves. This has become one of our greatest challenges lately - the lack of affordable housing. This is a nationwide crisis and brings new challenges to our efforts, every single day. In true Welcome Home fashion, we're looking at every possible opportunity to tackle those challenges. With relentless pursuit, we're digging in our heels to find solutions. We're creating ways to partner with landlords and developers who want to have a role in the Welcome Home mission – to honor veterans and restore lives. We simply will not rest until we achieve that mission.

We believe in what we do and your support tells us you believe in it, too. We are motivated by that belief every single day – 365 days a year.

KEY PROGRAMS & SERVICES

All support and wrap-around services are customized to meet the needs and goals of each individual Veteran, including intensive case management, advocacy, and an opportunity to build a greater quality of life. Our key programs include:



EMERGENCY & TRANSITIONAL SHELTER

32 rooms/34 beds with full bathrooms for literally homeless Veterans, including a separate corridor for our female Veterans and families, as well as ADA rooms for those with disabilities.



PERMANENT HOUSING

Supportive services and temporary financial assistance to help Veterans and their families who are homeless, or at-risk of homelessness, secure or sustain permanent, affordable, and stable housing.




VETS WORK

Job readiness training and direct support to help unemployed or underemployed Veterans find and keep meaningful employment.

IMPACTS & OUTCOMES

Through Welcome Home's comprehensive programs and services, homeless and atrisk Veterans gain wrap-around support, ensuring access to essential resources such as shelter, well-balanced meals, and necessary supplies. We also provide transportation, employment assistance, and both permanent and rapid re-housing services. Each Veteran receives individualized case management, advocacy, connection to VA-eligible benefits, as well as opportunities for recreational and therapeutic activities. By connecting them with collaborating partners, we ensure Veterans receive the mental, physical, and emotional resources they need. Ultimately, our goal is to help every Veteran achieve a better quality of life — a life they truly deserve.

SPECIAL NOTE FROM A VETERAN PARTICIPANT

In the past two months that I have lived here, Welcome Home has provided me with a stable, secure & safe environment. I have here a setting in which to regain my emotional stability. I have been fighting clinical depression for over two years, and only after a second inpatient stay on 2B in the VA Hospital for medication readjustment in May 2023 did I become eligible for services here. I served honorably & proudly. I feel that Welcome Home honors us, the Veterans. We all have reasons to be here. I feel that the program attempts to fulfill each Veterans' individual needs as well as it can.

I have found my case manager and staff to be excellent teachers and mentors. All staff members I have interacted with have been outstanding individuals, they are all number one folks. I'm still fighting the housing battle, I am working against a poor credit score & poor rental history. I am not giving up. As rental property in Columbia, MO is so high, I realize that I might have to stay through the entire 120 day program. I am still fighting. I want to thank all staff members for their dedication, time, & hard work to make Welcome Home a safe, stable, & secure setting to regain my life.


