At Welcome Home, we understand that stable housing is the foundation for rebuilding lives. That's why we are committed to providing both emergency shelter and permanent housing solutions for veterans in need. Whether it's a safe place to stay in times of crisis or a long-term home where veterans can regain stability, we ensure they have access to secure housing that supports their journey forward.

Beyond housing, we provide wraparound services that help veterans rebuild their lives. From employment assistance and financial counseling to health care and mental wellness support, we take an integrated approach to ensure veterans have the stability and resources they need to thrive.

But this mission is only possible because of the unwavering dedication of our incredible team. Our staff, volunteers, and community partners work tirelessly, day in and day out, to ensure every veteran who walks through our doors is met with compassion, support, and real solutions. They do more than just provide shelter, they restore hope. They go beyond to help veterans rebuild their lives, offering guidance, care, and the resources needed to transition into stable, self-sustaining housing.

In 2024 alone, we provided 17,236 bed nights of shelter to homeless veterans and their families. We served 51,978 nutritious, well-balanced meals. We assisted 500 veterans and family members through our comprehensive programs and services. But numbers only tell part of the story. What matters most is the transformation—restoring dignity, rebuilding lives, and ensuring every veteran has the resources and support they need to thrive.

As a veteran who has faced similar challenges, I am honored to serve as President of the Board and humbly dedicate myself to this mission. I know firsthand the uncertainties that can come after service, and I believe deeply in the importance of a strong community and unwavering support.

At Welcome Home, we believe every veteran deserves a place to call home. The affordable housing crisis continues to make stability difficult for those who have served our country, but we are committed to changing that. Through strong partnerships with property managers and developers who share our vision, we're working to create sustainable, long-term housing solutions for veterans in need. Together, we can ensure that every veteran who walks through our door finds the stability and security they deserve.

To all those who stand beside us—our supporters, our volunteers, and our community allies—thank you. Your belief in this mission fuels our work, every single day, all 365 days a year. Together, we are proving that no veteran should ever have to face homelessness. Together, we are restoring lives.

KEY PROGRAMS & SERVICES

All support and wrap-around services are customized to meet the needs and goals of each individual veteran, including intensive case management, advocacy, and an opportunity to build a greater quality of life. Our key programs include:



EMERGENCY & TRANSITIONAL SHELTER

- Homeless outreach and services empowering
 Veterans to get back on their feet and improve their overall quality of life
- 32 private rooms for homeless Veterans (men, women, & families): dining/community room, commercial kitchen, computer lab, lounge area, laundry and shower facilities, walking trail and garden area
- Wrap-around supportive services: individualized, intensive case management; connection to VA benefits, transportation, healthcare, recovery, and legal assistance
- Employment assistance, including resume and interview prep, job placement assistance, and training opportunitie



PERMANENT HOUSING

- Permanent and rapid rehousing for Veterans and their families: intensive case management, financial planning, connection to VA benefits and services
- Financial assistance for upfront housing expenses like rent, move-in deposits, security and utility deposits, household essentials and supplies
- Affordable housing identification and advocacy: landlord mediation, transportation, improve capacity for long-term housing, income, and personal stability
- Homelessness prevention and diversion assistance, including outreach to rural communities

IMPACTS & OUTCOMES

Through Welcome Home's comprehensive programs and services, homeless and at-risk veterans gain wrap-around support, ensuring access to essential resources such as shelter, well-balanced meals, and necessary supplies. We also provide transportation, employment assistance, and both permanent and rapid rehousing services.

Each veteran receives individualized case management, advocacy, connection to VA-eligible benefits, as well as opportunities for recreational and therapeutic activities. By connecting them with collaborating partners, we ensure veterans receive the mental, physical, and emotional resources they need. Ultimately, our goal is to help every veteran achieve a better quality of life — a life they truly deserve.



IMPACT STORIES

D'S JOURNEY HOME

Last fall, veteran, D., re-entered the Welcome Home shelter program after a challenging period marked by hardship and resilience. A few years prior, he had successfully transitioned into stable housing through our efforts.

Unfortunately, a failed relationship led to his unexpected homelessness. The woman he was involved with falsely claimed to reside in his apartment, resulting in a tumultuous legal battle that left D. incarcerated for a time. Upon his release, he found himself barred from his own home while awaiting court proceedings.

Determined to help, the team at Welcome Home welcomed D. back into our shelter program, guiding him through the complexities of his situation.

Thankfully, D. was eventually exonerated, allowing him to return to his apartment. However, the reunion was heartbreaking. His once-cozy space had been vandalized, and all of his personal belongings—documents, keepsakes, and precious photos of his daughter—were gone or destroyed.

With the support of our staff, D. faced this daunting reality. While we couldn't replace the irreplaceable memories, we ensured he had food, a safe place to sleep, and compassionate assistance through case management. After several months in our program, D. was ready to move back home. Yet, he lacked the furniture needed to transform his apartment back into a haven.

Thanks to the generosity of our partners at Bob Woodruff Foundation, our staff was able to help D. shop for essential furniture, giving him the opportunity to revitalize his living space.

Overwhelmed with gratitude, D. expressed, "Thanks for today. I got a couple of pieces of furniture, and I would like to thank everyone involved for their efforts in getting me back to my home. I couldn't have done it without you."

D.'s journey reflects the profound impact of our community's support and exemplifies the mission of Welcome Home: to restore dignity and stability to those in need. Together, we're making a difference, one story at a time.
